RULES

1. Objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the end of the class along with a £10 deposit. The judges decision is final.
2. Only horses/ponies of four years and over may be ridden at the event.
3. Dogs to be kept under close control and on leads at all times.
4. Children under 16 years of age must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
5. The organizers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take responsibility for the behaviour of their own horses and must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and officials.
6. All competitors and members of the public are requested to notify the secretary of any accidents, incidents or potential hazards as soon as reasonably practicable after they occur or are identified.
7. Horses are easily frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from the horse areas and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.
8. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, the organisers accept no liability for any loss or damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, vehicles or any property or persons howsoever arising.
9. Hard hats to PAS015 or EN1384 with chin straps fastened must be worn at all times when mounted. Gloves are mandatory in dressage. Spurs not exceeding 1cm may be worn and whips not exceeding 110cm may be carried.
10. No entry fee will be refunded without the provision of a Doctor's or Vet's Certificate.
