A cancellation fee may apply of up to 25% if the event is cancelled.

NO Entry will be accepted without correct and full payment at close of entry.

IMPORTANT NOTES

See separate Pontispool schedule for details of the format of the competition. The penalty scores will determine placings.

As this competition is being run on an all weather surface the XC speeds are based on BE Arena Eventing speeds rather than the Challenge speeds in the rulebook, in the interests of safety.

This competition will be run on the all weather surface but including the new permanent XC fences and unless ground conditions permit, there will be limited warm up time and space available. A fixed amount of time will be allocated to each rider in the warm up area.

THE COMPETITION

- Arena Eventing is a two phase competition, run at BE80, BE90 and BE100 level where Area 12 riders can qualify for the Festival of the Horse, 18-19 May 2019 Washbrook Farm, Aston-le-Walls, Daventry, Northamptonshire NN11 6RT
- Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by cross country fences, and will finish with the last fence as a show jump, the joker fence. The joker fence will be approximately 10cm higher than the rest of the course, if you knock the Joker fence down you will incur 6 penalties.
- The optimum time will be based on a speed of 375mpm
- They will run at BE80, BE90 & BE100 level.
- The classes are open to all, inc RC non-members.
- Horses 4 years of age and above may compete in 80 classes
- Horses must be 5 years of age and above to compete in 90 and 100 classes
- British Riding Club/British Eventing compliant cross country kit must be worn.
- **Stop watches are not permitted**
- Clear rounds take precedence over anyone with jumping faults and the winner will be the one nearest to the optimum time with a clear round. In the event of a tie the winner will be the one closest to, but under the optimum time, with a clear round.
- Time allowed is twice the optimum time.
- There will be a drawn order and approximate start times will be given in advance of the day although the course will only be open for walking before the class starts.
- There will be one section run at each height.
- The Judges' decision is final.

Clubs are required to supply one helper for 2 hours per team entered. Please include the name and contact email address and telephone number of your nominated helper(s) on the entry form. Area 12 entries will not be accepted without this. Early notification appreciated by email to h_pavey@yahoo.co.uk.

DECLARATIONS Qualifier declaration sheets to be handed in together with all photocopies of passport/fluvac pages in a clear plastic sleeve (one per team) prior to first horses competing. Hats and body protectors must be checked before mounting. Bring to the Secretary when you collect your number. See current rulebook / BRC website for details.

ELIGIBILITY AND RC RULES IMPORTANT Refer to current BRC rulebook for full details and READ back page of this schedule.. Relevant date for age of Junior riders is under 18 on 1st Jan 2018. Horses can compete in one class. Riders may compete in the same class as an individual AND as a team member provided different horses/ponies are ridden.

For Riding Club Qualifier Horses/ponies must NOT compete at the equivalent Pontispool event less than 5 days prior to the competition and must not have schooled over the permanent XC fences within the preceding 5 days of the competition.

Note - Vaccination rules for qualifying entries and rule G7.3 regarding disqualification. Teams can consist of 4 Junior or 4 Senior riders, best 3 scores to count or Teams of 3 may compete, all 3 scores to count. Non qualifying teams may consist of mixed Junior and Senior teams. In case of over subscription, qualifying teams will take priority.
